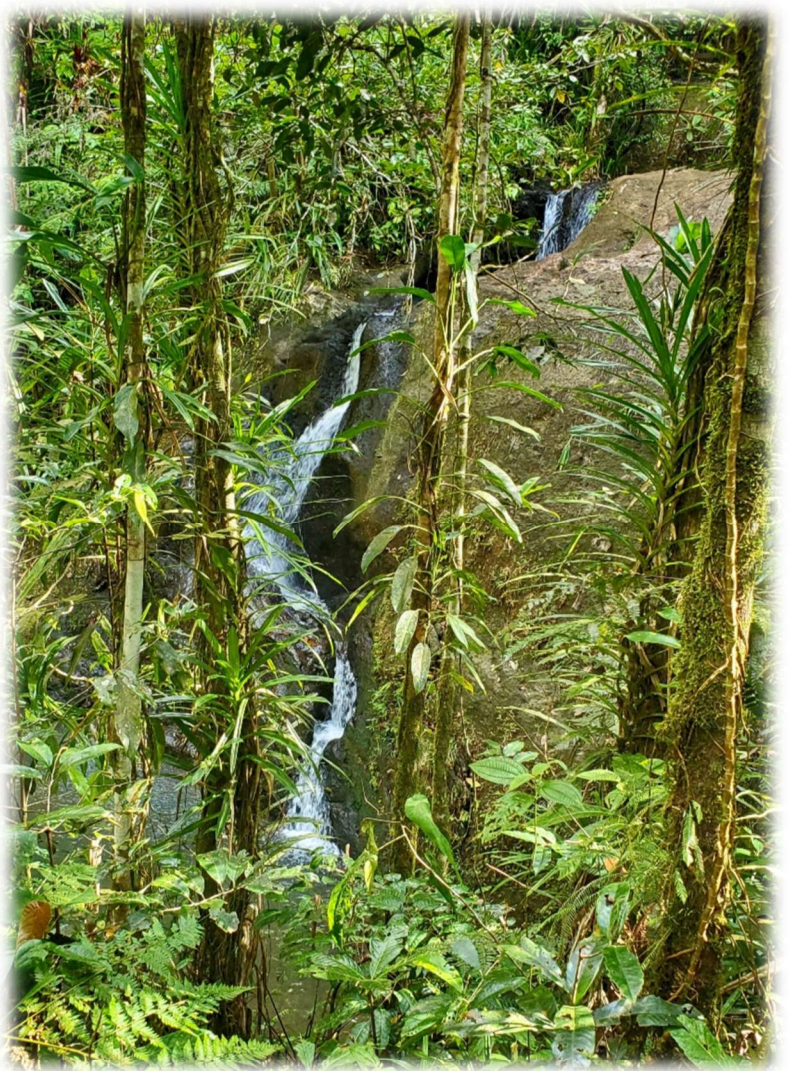

After the ladies went to church, we took a hike in Colo-i-Suva Park.









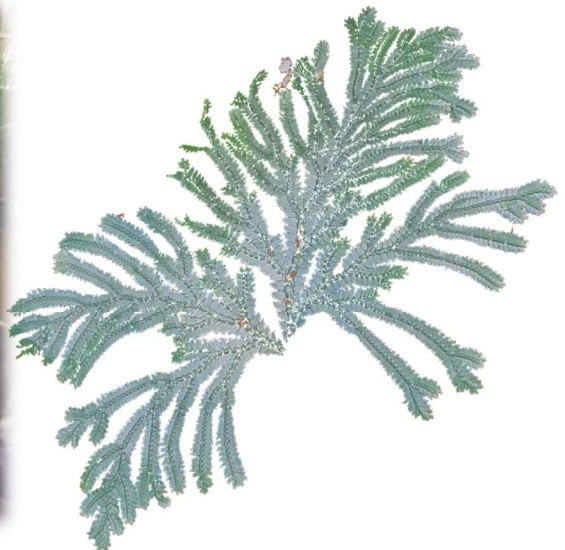
